Cementitious Piping O & M Initial & Annual Certification

A Negative Exposure Assessment was conducted and determined that the employee exposure levels of asbestos is below the Permissible Exposure Limits, PEL, therefore certain Personal Protective Equipment, PPE, are not required such as Tyvek suits and Respirators.



Does your system have asbestos pipe?

If you are not sure, according to SCDHEC, a utility is to assume they have asbestos pipe if they have any cement pipe installed prior to the mid- 1980's and cannot prove what type of pipe it is.



SCDHEC requires anyone who repairs or replaces asbestos utility lines to take an approved initial course and a refresher course annually and to be licensed. Certificates of completion must be submitted to SCDHEC annually for proof of compliance.

FROST TRAINING & CONSULTING, LLC developed this course, with the approval of SCDHEC and OSHA, and is specifically designed as a "1-Day Course" for public utility workers who cut and repair Cementitious pipe. It is the first and only course of its kind in the State.
